

SCRIPTURE READING PLAN FOR 5786 (2025-2026)

This Bible Reading Plan is more than simply a tool for reading through the Bible in a year. The Bible shapes the worldview of Christians and Jews, but too often neither understands how the other approaches the scriptures. That's why the intent behind this reading plan is to help Christians understand how our Jewish brethren have approached the scriptures for millennia in the interest of promoting interfaith dialogue, understanding, and mutual respect.

This plan takes the Torah and Haftarah cycle as the foundation for reading the entire Bible. Torah and Haftarah readings follow the one-year Jewish and Messianic divisions, with Torah readings divided into daily portions and Haftarah readings occurring on Shabbat. Torah and Haftarah readings for the *Moedim* (Feasts of the Lord) appear in *italics*. Readings for the rest of the Tanakh (Old Testament) and Apostolic Writings (New Testament) proceed through a daily plan that covers the entire Bible over the course of the year. Note that chapter and verse designations are according to the Christian rather than Jewish numbering.

Jewish tradition assigns special places to Esther, Song of Solomon, Ruth, Lamentations, and Ecclesiastes. These five, known as the Megillot (Scrolls), are read during observances that correspond to the theme of each:

Esther	Purim	March 2-3, 2026
Song of Solomon	Pesach (Passover)	April 1-9, 2026
Ruth	Shavuot (Pentecost)	May 21-23, 2026
Lamentations	9 th of Av (Tisha b'Av)	July 21-23, 2026
Ecclesiastes	Sukkot (Tabernacles)	September 25-October 2, 2026

Two other books are read in their entirety on specific days: Jonah on Yom Kippur, and Obadiah as the Haftarah for the Torah portion Vayishlach (Genesis 32:3-36:43).

The Psalms and Proverbs are presented in daily readings rather than sequentially with the rest of the Tanakh. An interesting feature about Psalms is that its five divisions (Books I-V) correspond to the five books of Moses as follows:

Book I	Psalms 1-41	Genesis
Book II	Psalms 42-72	Exodus
Book III	Psalms 73-89	Leviticus
Book IV	Psalms 90-106	Numbers
Book V	Psalms 107-150	Deuteronomy

Each section of Psalms is paired with the corresponding book of the Torah. Readings from Proverbs are interspersed throughout the year.

The first weekly readings for the year 5786 correspond to the final readings of the previous cycle, which is why this plan begins with the last chapters of both the Tanakh and Apostolic Writings.¹

³Chanukah, the Feast of Dedication (or Rededication) of the Temple, is sundown December 14 to sundown December 22. The customary reading is Numbers 7:1-8:4 (read in portions over the eight days of the feast), which tells of Israel's offerings at the dedication of the Tabernacle. The Shabbat during Chanukah (December 20) has a special reading from Zechariah 2:10-4:7, the prophet's vision of the menorah in the heavenly Temple.

⁴Asara b'Tevet (Fast of the 10th Month) occurs during daylight hours of December 30. This fast commemorates the beginning of the siege of Jerusalem by Nebuchadnezzar. Customary readings are Exodus 32:11-34:10 and Isaiah 55:6-56:8.

⁵ The Shabbat before the first of Adar (or first of Adar II in a leap year) is Shabbat Shekalim (Sabbath of Shekels) in remembrance of the commandment for all male Hebrews to contribute half a shekel for maintenance of the Tabernacle. The custom is to read from Exodus 30 and 2 Kings 12, which tell of the commandment and its application in the First Temple period. Shabbat Shekalim is observed in preparation for Purim. This is in addition to the customary Rosh Chodesh (New Moon) reading of Numbers 28:9-15.

⁶ The Shabbat preceding Purim is called Shabbat Zachor, the Sabbath of Remembrance. Haman, the villain in the Purim story, was a descendant of Amalek. Since the Torah includes a command to remember what Amalek did to Israel, it is customary to read the applicable passages from Deuteronomy 25 and 1 Samuel 15.

⁷ Ta'anit Esther (Fast of Esther) is March 2. This dawn-to-dusk fast is observed the day before Purim. The customary reading is Exodus 32:11-24:10. Purim is sundown March 2 to sundown March 3. It is customary to read the book of Esther on Purim, as well as Exodus 17:8-16, which relates Israel's first encounter with Amalek.

⁸ March 7 is Shabbat Parah, the Sabbath of the Red Heifer, which is observed on the Shabbat before Shabbat HaChodesh. As a reminder to begin preparations for Pesach, the traditional reading is Numbers 19:1-22, which explains the purpose of the red heifer in purification of the nation, and Ezekiel 36:16-38, which is a prophecy of Israel's purification and restoration in the latter days.

⁹ March 14 is Shabbat HaChodesh (Sabbath of the Month), the Shabbat before the first day of Nisan. Since Nisan is the first month on the Hebrew calendar and the month of Pesach, the special Shabbat HaChodesh Torah reading is Exodus 12:1-20, which explains the commandments regarding Passover. This is in addition to the customary Rosh Chodesh (New Moon) reading from Numbers 28. The Shabbat HaChodesh Haftarah is Ezekiel 45:16-46:18, which specifies the offerings to happen in the Millennial Temple during Messiah's reign.

¹⁰ March 28 is Shabbat HaGadol, the Great Sabbath. This is the Shabbat immediately before Pesach. The special preparatory reading is from Malachi.

¹¹ Pesach (Passover) is sundown April 1 to sundown April 9. Matzot (Unleavened Bread) begins sundown April 2, continuing through sundown April 9.

¹² Yom Habikkurim (First Fruits), as observed by many Messianic followers of Yeshua, is April 4-5 (sundown to sundown), which corresponds with Resurrection Sunday in the Christian tradition. That is also the date many Messianic believers begin to count the Omer. Traditional Jewish practice is to begin counting the Omer on the second day of Passover. That means the traditional Jewish observance of Shavuot always occurs on the 6th day of the month of Sivan and falls on different days during the week. The Messianic observance always starts the Omer count on Sunday, which means Shavuot will always fall on Sunday, but will be on different dates during the month of Sivan. This Bible Reading Plan follows the Messianic observance, but will make note of the traditional Jewish date for Shavuot.

¹³ A Shabbat that falls on the first day of a month, such as April 18, is a Shabbat Rosh Chodesh. The customary reading is Isaiah 66, along with Numbers 28:9-15.

¹⁹ The traditional Haftara for Shoftim does not include Isaiah 53. It is included here because of its significant prophecy about Messiah as the Suffering Servant.

²³ Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) is sundown September 20 to sundown September 21. The traditional readings for Yom Kippur include the book of Jonah.

²⁴ Sukkot (Tabernacles) begins at sundown September 25 and continues to sundown October 4 (Simchat Torah).
